

Active Communities Team Performance Report October 2018 – March 2019

Key highlights include:

Active Community Development Team

- The Halloween Witches Walk attracted over 3,400 local residents
- Successful Holiday Camp delivered at Ambrose Barlow High School
- Over 1,400 attendances were recorded at half term holiday activities across the city
- Parkour sessions were delivered across the city as part of a Citywide Knife crime awareness project
- New season of the JP school football league started at Salford Sports Village with 22 teams

Salford Youth Alliance

- Over 100 volunteers now registered with 2,000 hours of volunteering given back to the local community

Arts Development

- Salford Cultural Education Partnership have been awarded £1 million by Arts Council England to deliver a three year Performing Arts programme. 9 community theatre projects for young people will be delivered through current SCL provision
- The team have successfully been awarded £25,000 by the Salford Ambition for Ageing Programme to test and learn an Age Friendly Arts and Culture offer in Seedley and Weaste, Langworthy and Broughton until March 2020

Dance

- The team have held three exam sessions with the International Dance Teachers association. In total 378 performers exams were taken over the three sessions
- In partnership with MAPAS the team produced its first Musical Theatre production at The Lowry Theatre

CTS Swimming

- Lancashire County Championships - 85 County Qualifiers and an enormous medal haul of 100 Medals
- Coach Adam Naylor was selected as Head Coach of England Talent Regional Programme North West
- Coach Danielle Naylor selected to coach the County team at the National County Championships

Greater Manchester Sports Awards 2018

Salford swimmer Ewan Wilson won the prestigious Greater Manchester Sports Performer of the Year 2018 Award. Facing opposition and nominees from all the other boroughs in Greater Manchester Ewan was chosen as the winner of this converted award.

Ewan's achievements have included a Silver Medal at the National Championships in the 200 Fly along with multiple Gold medals at Counties and Regional Championships.

Ewan was also commended for his commitment and dedication to swimming which involves catching trains, buses and taxis to training along with his contributions to voluntary help in the community.



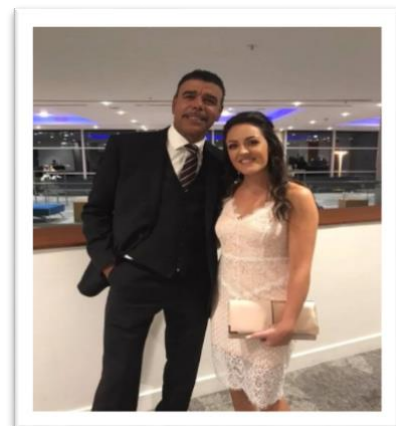
Synchro Swimming

- 2 swimmers won bronze in the 13-15 years duet at National Championships
- 4 squad swimmers attended England trials in Bristol. One swimmer was selected for England Age Group Team and two swimmers were selected for the England Development Team
- 1 gold and 2 silver medals were won at the National Age Groups, the team's best results to date

Salford Sports Awards 2018: Coach of the year

Jess has been coaching Synchro for over 10 years. In 2011 she set up the City of Salford Synchronised Swimming Club and has taken the swimmers from grassroots through to National level, with 4 swimmers on National programmes.

She has recently completed her IOS tutor training programme which will allow her to run Synchro courses for new coaches and she also plays an active role working with the North West Synchro programme.
